Key Themes	The Nicholas Hamond Academy:	As a Pupil I will:	As a Parent/Carer - I/We will:
Start and end of the academy day	Marks on the floor to show where to safely wait. Create clear waiting spaces for each group. Provide a one way system through the academy. Have designated entrances for year group bubbles. Have staff on duty to ensure students go to the correct areas.	To enter the academy with my face covering on and through the designated entrance. Enter the academy through my designated entrance and go to my form room. Exit the academy through my designated exit. Attend a detention on time if set.	Ensure my child attends the academy on the right day and arrives on time Follow the one-way system in and out of the academy To support and arrange transport if needed for after school detentions.
Break & Lunch times	Create safe spaces for each group to socialise and have their break away from other groups	Stay in my designated area. Keep to social distancing guidance at social times. Act in an appropriate manner at all times. Attend a detention on time if set.	Support the school with sanctions put into place.
Contacting staff	Communicate any issues via phone or email	Ensure I tell adults of any issues during the day.	Call or email school with any concerns that I may have. Be polite and courteous to staff at all times understanding that staff are working at all times to minimize risks.
Cleanliness	Ensure that we have soap and hand sanitiser readily available and that regular handwashing is insisted upon. Desks will be regularly sanitised throughout the day. Make sure that environments are kept clean. Provide access to drinking water for students throughout the day.	Not bring anything unnecessary to school including my mobile phone Wash my hands when I am told to Sneeze and cough into a tissue and put the tissue in to the bin straight away. Eat my meals sitting where I am asked to. Try to keep some safe space between me and my friends.	Make sure that my children are kept clean wearing clean clothes. Make sure my child washes their hands before leaving the house Make sure that no unnecessary personal belonging, are brought into the academy
Social distancing and safe behaviours	Insist on maintaining distance, as much as we are able and maintain high levels of hygiene for all members of the academy community and the environment. To ensure students are wearing face coverings except for when outside, eating or performing sports. Follow up with sanctions for students that are not doing this.	To wear a face covering at all times, with the exception of when eating, outside or in PE. Be respectful to people all the time. Keep my friends safe by not hugging them or touching them. Walk home, socially distancing myself from others.	Talk to my child about the need for high levels of hygiene. This includes not hugging, holding hands, sharing their drinks/food, spitting etc as well as washing hands thoroughly when asked to and when they wish to Ensure my child follows social distancing when not in the academy which includes coming to and from the academy
Well being	Provide care and nurture for your child as we always have done	Follow the new rules in the academy to keep everybody safe.	Support us as we endeavour to get the children back to the
Lessons	Ensure high expectations in all classes to ensure a positive learning environment. To follow the behaviour policy consistently to ensure students learning is not disrupted by poor behaviour.	To follow the rules and expectations within my lesson. To treat everyone with respect. To sit in my designated seat facing forwards at all time. To follow all instructions first time. To have Pride in my work and complete it to the best of my ability.	To support the academy in enforcing high expectations and standards within our classes. To support the academy with sanction.
Uniform & Equipment	To promote high standards of personal appearance and uniform. To complete morning standards checks to ensure students are in full uniform and have all equipment they need to learn.	To wear the full school uniform correctly each day, as set out in the uniform guide. I will bring in the necessary equipment for every lesson.	To support the academy in ensuring your child come in full school uniform. To contact the KSL in advance if there are any issues that prevent your child from wearing the full and correct uniform.
Illness and symptoms	Inform the parents of any positive cases in a timely manner. Call parents to collect individual children if they are ill in any other way. Keep any child displaying symptoms safely away from others in a designated room and care for them using PPE	Tell an adult straight away if I feel unwell in any way	Keep my child away from the academy if they display symptoms or if they are ill Call the academy to let them know that my child will not be in and why as soon as possible. Make sure the academy has at least 2 contact numbers and someone can be contacted throughout the day
