### Year 7:

Session	Aim:
Careers: STEM	RAF Marham will deliver a session on STEM careers and their importance, with activities involving working as a team. Trainers are required for this session.
PSHE/RSE: Send me a Pic – lesson 1	To identify healthy and unhealthy characteristics of relationships online and understand features of a situation where it's more risky to share a nude image.
PSHE/RSE: Classifications and avoiding peer pressure – lesson 1	Learning to make decisions and manage peer pressure about films and online viewing
PSHE: Money management	Learning how to manage money through various transactions

Session	Aim
Careers: transferable skills from History	To understand the skills used in History and how they transfer into the world of work

PSHE: Substance Abuse: class B drugs	Identify the dangers of Class B Drugs and the harm they can cause.
