Welcome back to a busy term! Before the summer holidays, the SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities) team have been working hard to ensure that the offers of intervention and support this academic year meet the needs of our young learners. Each term, students on the SEND register will be set targets in English, Maths and if applicable SEMH (Social, Emotional and Mental Health) and attendance, which are specific for each student. These will be sent home at the beginning of each term so please look out for them in the coming weeks. These are designed to be SMART and effective so that you can support them at home. Please do ask them how they are progressing towards their targets and even better support them at home weekly by working on them. This might be through reading aloud to you or helping them with spellings they are struggling with to practicing their times tables at home.

Element 3 Funding:

You may or may not be aware that Norfolk County Council have ceased SEND Element 3 Funding for the next two terms. Whilst this will undoubtedly have implications for all schools, we will continue to offer a strong curriculum in school to support your child as best we can.
