| 30 Minutes  | 16 days from school                      | 95 lessons lost                         |

## Persistent Absence

Persistent absentees are those that have missed more than 10% of their school sessions. In a year there are 190 teaching days, if a child misses 19 days or more, then they will fall into this bracket. Children who are persistently absent will be very closely monitored to ensure that their attendance improves,
