Norwich Playhouse Theatre - 7th October.**

I am delighted to be writing to inform you about the first theatre trip for our new Year 10 GCSE drama students. As you will be aware, an important part of the Drama GCSE course is to be able to analyse and evaluate live theatre performance. In order to prepare the students for this, we will be going to watch ‘Sherlock Holmes and the Hunt for Moriarty’ at the Norwich Playhouse Theatre on Tuesday 7th October.

We will visit the food court at Chantry Place so students have the opportunity to buy dinner, or to bring their own if they choose. We will also pass a local Tesco to buy snacks.
