## Curriculum Day - 6<sup>th</sup> November 2025

The first of our 'Curriculum Days' of the year for all students takes place on 6th November. Curriculum Days are days where students will not be following their normal timetabled lessons, but will instead have sessions based around PSHE and Careers topics, appropriate to the Year group your child is in. These days are run to compliment the tutor time and LOOL lessons students experience and prepare them for life in modern Britain.
