These mock exams are a vital opportunity for students to experience formal examination conditions and to assess their progress ahead of their final GCSE examinations this summer.

All examinations will take place in school under standard exam conditions. Students are expected to arrive promptly, in full school uniform, and fully equipped. Morning examinations will begin at **9:00am** and afternoon examinations at **11:45am**, unless stated otherwise.
