- *Dress Code: Formal prom attire*

To ensure that the prom is enjoyable, safe, and respectful for all students, staff, and venue partners, we ask all parents and carers to support the following expectations. These standards apply both in the lead-up to the event and on the day itself.

Conduct and Effort in School:

- *Students should continue to demonstrate positive behaviour, good attendance, and engagement in lessons throughout the remainder of Year 11.*
- *Serious behaviour incidents, persistent defiance, or actions that compromise the safety or wellbeing of others may result in a student being withdrawn from attending prom.*

Behaviour on the Day of Prom:

- *Students must not consume alcohol, drugs, vapes, or any prohibited substances before or during the event.*
- *The school reserves the right to refuse entry to any student suspected to be under the influence.*
- *Students must show respectful behaviour towards school staff, hotel staff, and other guests at all times.*

Safety and Conduct During the Event

- *Students must remain within the designated prom areas and follow all instructions from staff.*
- *No dangerous, illegal, or inappropriate items may be brought to the event.*
- *Any student whose behaviour places themselves or others at risk may be asked to leave, and parents/carers will be contacted.*

Travel Arrangements

- *Parents/carers must ensure students have safe and reliable transport to and from the venue.*
- *Students must be collected promptly at the end of the event.*

Mobile Phones & Social Media

- *Students should use phones sensibly and respectfully.*
- *Posting inappropriate content, sharing images without consent, or any form of bullying may lead to consequences, including removal from the event.*
