**Cambridge Arts Theatre – 17<sup>th</sup> September 2026**

I am delighted to be writing to you to inform you of the latest TNHA theatre visit. We are going to the **Cambridge Arts Theatre** to see a performance of the smash hit musical **'BLOOD BROTHERS'**.

The trip will take place on **Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> September**. The cost of the tickets is **£42.50** each, **£35** for students eligible for FSM or pupil premium. The coach will leave TNHA at **4pm** and we anticipate arrival back at TNHA at around **11.15pm**.

Students must hand in the attached consent form to me by **May Half Term**. I will then draw for places on the trip. A list of places will be available to students by **5<sup>th</sup> June**, on the Creative Arts notice board outside the drama & music rooms. The cost of the ticket will appear on the MCAS accounts of successful applicants the following week. You will be emailed about whether your child has received a place on the trip and what to do next. You will need to ensure the trip is paid for by **1<sup>st</sup> July**. Students who fail to follow the school behaviour policy will not be able to take a place on the trip.

Students will be able to wear their own clothes on the trip, but these must be appropriate for a school theatre trip. Students should bring snacks and drinks for the journey. We will be able to get food at food outlets like MacDonaldis and Subway once at the venue. Students are welcome to bring a small amount of money to buy snacks in the foyer of the theatre but do so at their own risk.
