Year 7:

Session	Aim
PSHE: Understanding menstruation	Students will understand the purpose of menstruation and will look at products that can be used for it, as well as the signs of when you may need to seek medical advice.
PSHE: First Aid	This session with Medicare will help students learn how to give vital first aid when required. Students will be practicing the different forms of first aid.
Careers: Young Enterprise	Students will work with Pat Trimmer from Young Enterprise to learn about employability skills and how and where they are used. They will then use these skills to create their own business.
PSHE: Relationships	Paula Devaux will be coming to work with students to look at relationships and how to identify when a relationship has become toxic, as well as how to maintain a positive relationship.
PSHE: Kickboxing	Trevor will be joining students to show them the basics of kickboxing, as well as discussing the health benefits.

Year 8:

Session	Aim
Careers: RAF Marham	RAF Marham will be discussing STEM careers and their importance in the world of work. Students will then work as teams to build aeroplanes and evaluate their ability to work as a team.
Careers: WEX – Skills needed in the work place	Kath Wyatt will be joining us to help develop entrepreneurial skills with the students. They will design a fundraising event and present their ideas to the rest of the class.
PSHE: MHST and mental health	MHST will be working with the students to help them understand at times we all struggle with mental health, the signs to look out for and ask students to partake in some wellbeing activities to help support their own mental health.
PSHE: Deep fakes	Students will learn about the different types of deep fakes and how to detect them. They will go on to consider the impact that deep fakes can have on someone's life.

Year 9:

Session	Aim
PSHE: Illegal drugs	In this session students will learn about the negative effects of both legal and illegal drugs and the harm they can cause to the body
PSHE: Practising safe sex	Students will identify features of unsafe sex and the different methods of contraception. During this session students will apply a condom to a condom training penis model.
PSHE/careers: Barclays visit 4:	The students will have their fourth and final visit from Barclays where they will explore the core key skill of adaptability and how this can be shown through traits and skills.
Careers: Morgan Sindall and employability skills	Morgan Sindall will be joining the students to discuss key employability skills such as communication, teamwork and problem solving through a variety of hands-on tasks. Students will also learn about the different roles within the building industry.
PSHE/Careers: Planning for and meeting other's needs	Tanya will be joining us to consider the different needs of groups of individuals and discover suitable financial options that would meet those needs.

Session	Aim
Careers: Next steps after GCSEs	Our career advisor Robert will be discussing with students all of their possible options following GCSEs, in readiness for students making their College applications when we return in September.
Careers: ICEYE	Andy will join Y10s and consider the practical elements of selling themselves in an interview as well as thinking about the technology industry and the types of jobs there are.
Careers: Games Jam	Louise Mayo from Access Creative College will be joining students where they will design their own concept of a computer game and deliver a pitch to the class about it. Students will develop creative and communication skills and learn concepts around PEGI certification, primary and secondary audiences, representation and monetisation
PSHE: Cancer prevention, screening and self-examination	This session will help students to understand the importance of taking increased personal responsibility for maintaining and monitoring health, including cancer prevention, screening and self-examination. Understandably this session may be difficult for some students, so please do let myself and your child's tutor know if you feel your child will be upset by this topic, so that we can ensure we have support in place for them.
